DM WIMS MEDICAL COLLEGE HOSPITAL, WAYANAD

The Medical College teaching hospital was established in 2010 on 50 acres of land at Naseera Nagar, Meppadi. EMERGENCY MEDICINE (EM)

Emergency Medicine (EM) is a relatively new specialty within medicine that is expanding at a phenomenal pace throughout the globe. Within the international community, leaders in medicine, health economics, public health, and government have recognized the need to develop systems that respond to acute medical and surgical emergencies. Emergency medicine is the unique discipline and independent specialty with a unique body of knowledge that focuses on responding to these life-threatening events. Many countries have already recognized the specialty of EM and offer specific training programs in emergency medicine. India has initiated a few training programs at a limited number of institutions, but an enormous critical need still exists to train many more Emergency Physicians for the nation's large demand for these healthcare providers. The vast majority of emergency care in India is provided by persons working in Emergency Departments who have had little or no formalized training in the specialty. This Diploma program has been designed for those practicing physicians, a targeted educational program to enhance their formal training in Emergency Medicine.

The Ronald Reagan Institute of Emergency Medicine (RRIEM) at the George Washington University aims to launch the 1-year Post-graduate Diploma Program in Emergency Medicine in partnership with Dr. Moopen's Academy an Institution dedicated to Emergency Medicine in India. Together, we will train physicians in various centers in India, and prepare these Diploma candidates to practice in the complex and challenging arena of emergency medicine.

Through didactic and clinical instruction by faculty qualified in Emergency Medicine, the Diploma candidates will have guidance and education in the specific topics and skills that constitute the field of emergency medicine. The faculty will provide lectures, seminars, simulations, and clinical teaching to the Diploma candidates. The quality of the education programs will be maintained through continuous assessments of the Diploma candidates, the faculty, and the overall Diploma program.

Dr. Moopen's Academy, will prepare a new generation of leaders in medicine who will expand the field of Emergency Medicine throughout India.









Post-Graduate Diploma Program in Emergency Medicine

The post-graduate Diploma program in Emergency Medicine will consist of a one-year curriculum that will be divided into 12 clinical modules that will cover the breadth of emergency medicine. RRIEM with the host institution will provide visiting faculty and program oversight for the Diploma program. At the successful conclusion of the program, the graduating physicians will be better qualified to practice independently within emergency departments and they will receive a "Certificate of Completion" from the RRIEM at the George Washington University and the host institution.

Eligibility: MBBS and Registration with the Medical Council of India

A. Curriculum

The entire course is divided into 12 monthly modules covering the curriculum. Each module will begin with a pre-test to gauge the candidates' knowledge on clinical topics and end with a post-test to measure the candidates' level of comprehension and mastery of the materials of the module. Required readings will be assigned for each month. The mandatory 2 day contact session every month will consist of hands-on clinical and skills training. In addition, the candidates will receive a monthly set of educational assignments and responsibilities. A member of the faculty will be available to assist the candidates with any questions or concerns and to provide guidance.

The primary textbook will be "Emergency Medicine: A Comprehensive Study Guide" 6th edition edited by Judith E. Tintinalli. In addition, "Rosen's Emergency Medicine: Concepts and Clinical Practice" will serve as a supporting textbook, and "Clinical Procedures in Emergency Medicine" by James R. Roberts and Jerris Hedges will be used to teach necessary procedures in the emergency department. The Society for Academic Emergency Medicine (SAEM) and the Council of Emergency Medicine Residency Directors (CORD) have developed a "Model Curriculum for Emergency Medicine" (Appendix A), and this model curriculum will serve as a basis for the Diploma program's modular topics.

B. Educational Program

Fundamental components of the education program include:

- Clearly defined goals and objectives for the topic months
- · Lectures on the modular topic of the month
- Case based discussions and 'simulation' sessions
- · Evidence-based medicine
- · Journal article discussions
- · Grand rounds and guest speakers
- · Procedures and skills seminars

The content of the seminars will focus on the modular topic for the particular month. The Emergency Medicine faculty will also invite experts from other fields such as cardiology, surgery, and pediatrics to give guest lectures on important topics that are related to emergency medicine. Diploma candidates will be expected to read assigned chapters in their textbooks and to read relevant journal articles. RRIEM or the host institution will provide a faculty member onsite for 2 days each month during the program for intensive academic instruction and for project oversight. Program participants will be expected to travel to a designated location for these clinical sessions.

C. Distance Educational Component

The required readings and hands-on training sessions will be supplemented by a significant distance education component to the program. The RRIEM at the George Washington University have developed an interactive password protected website for the Diploma programs in India. The site includes the links to the various institutional web sites, curriculum information, and modular educational programs for the preceding and current months for the Diploma program, similar to the resources for the residency program at GWU. The educational material includes:

- Powerpoint presentations of the modular lectures
- Reading assignments
- · Supplemental powerpoint lectures

Journal club articles for the month Links to important procedural videos

D. Contact Program:

Participants are required to attend mandatory monthly contact sessions each of 2 days duration. These sessions will be conducted at selected centers at established hospitals with appropriate training facilities and trained staff as recognized by the stakeholders. Attendance and satisfactory completion of these sessions are essential for the completion of the diploma program and subsequent certification. A minimum of 10/12 sessions must be attended by each candidate in order to qualify to for the examination and certificate.

E. Evaluation and Assessment

The Diploma candidates will take monthly pre-tests and post-tests for each module topic to assess their continuous learning and incorporation of the emergency medicine knowledge and skills. The Diploma candidates will also be given an opportunity to provide feedback and assessments of the Diploma program and the instructors on periodic basis. A rigorous end of the year written and oral exam will be required for program completion. The senior members of the Society for Emergency Medicine in India (SEMI) will be invited to participate as oral examiners.

F. Local Faculty

All Local training centers are having sufficient number of faculty who are trained in Post Graduate Emergency Medicine program and has number of years expirience in the field. All the faculties are trained in curriculam implementation and managing an Emergency Medicine training program, and also Supplimental Clinical Training.
